**3. Planning**

**3.1 18/01574/FUL – The Coach House, Hawkridge Hill.**

*Demolish existing dwelling and erect new dwelling.*

Following a site meeting, councillors determined that they were not against the demolition of the existing dwelling and the development of a new home; however, they were opposed to this proposal. Councillors considered that the proposal is out of character with the immediate surrounding and with the other dwellings in Frilsham. The site can be seen from Brocks Lane and beyond, particularly when the trees are not in leaf.

It was agreed that Frilsham Parish Council **objects** to this application.
