1 To receive apologies for absence.

Apologies of absence were received from Cllr. Benning and Cllr. Goodenough.

2 To receive declarations of interest.

Cllr. Allum declared an interest in the planning application for Forge Cottage as an owner of adjacent land.

3 Planning.

3.1 To consider the following applications:

3.1.1 | 23/00695/HOUSE – Willow Cottage.

Demolition of conservatory and side extension. Extension of dwelling to sides, and rear, alterations and porch.

It was agreed that FPC has **no objection** to this application.

3.1.2 | 23/00763/HOUSE – Forge Cottage.

Erection of single storey rear extension and replacement of roof of existing extension; installation of rooflights.

It was agreed that FPC has no objection to this application.

4 Financial support for the Coronation BBQ (Sunday 7th May)

A request for £230 to cover alcoholic and non-alcoholic fizz, disposable flutes and prizes for the Coronation BBQ has been received. Whilst there were reservations about disposable flutes, particularly given the King's ecological views, the request was unanimously approved.

5 Printing copies of the Frilsham footpath Leaflet.

The Clerk obtained quotes from two companies for printing 50 and 100 leaflets. The prices for 50 leaflets were approximately £1.44 and £1.86 per leaflet.

It was agreed that Cllr. Allum would look at printing them and ultimately the Clerk could print a limited number.

6 Any Other Business.

6.1 Playarea.

Cllr. Lyon reported that the replacement floor panel for the multi-play unit had to be made to order and would cost £192. It is anticipated that this will be delivered with the replacement post.

Following a site visit, a quote for Tiger Mulch surfacing under the ordinary swings, the nest swing, the multi access swing and at the bottom of the slide, of just over £10,000 has been received.

6.2 Councillors.

Both Cllr. Benning and Cllr. Arnold have decided not to stand for re-election. Both were thanked for their efforts and hard work on FPC.
